### Hot Lunch

We have been given the go ahead to start Hot Lunch again! We know things are ever changing and that means things are going to look different. Starting in January, we will be offering two hot lunch days, by vendor only. We have a new set of rules with purchases, and essentially the most important one for you to know is that this is a purchase at your own risk. We will not be offering any refunds unless closures are mandated by the Government, in which case those will be done at the end of the year, minus any banking fees. We anticipate all students will be returning to in person classes come January. If any grades do not, and you have made a purchase, you will receive a credit to be used for when they do return. This credit will carry forward until they return, and the refunds will be activated as mentioned above should they never return come June. Full details of the policy are on the hot lunch website.
