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Student Drop Off and Pick Up

Please remember that all student drop off and pick up is to be done in the parking lot by the bus area. Currently many parents are using the teacher parking lot and this is very dangerous as well as a fire hazard.

Starting on February 8, 2021, all students from Early Education (3-4 Year Program) to Grade 12 are able to either register (new students) or verify their existing data (returning students) online.

To ensure that their child receives a bus pass prior to the start of the next school year, parents are required to complete registration by **4:30pm on March 25, 2021**. This deadline will facilitate the routing of buses, bus pass production and data verification before the summer break while schools are still operating.

To register a Returning Student for school and/or busing, **please check your email beginning February 8, 2021** for a message from "PowerSchool Registration Support" <noreply@noreply.psr.support.com> and follow the instructions in that email to complete the registration process.

Please Note:

You should receive one email for every returning student in your family. Please complete the registration/verification process for each one.

If you do not receive an email, please check your Spam or Junk folder.

If you check and confirm this original correspondence has not been received, and your child attends a Parkland School Division School, please [contact your school](#). If your child attends at any other partner school divisions or schools in the Regional Transportation system, contact Parkland School Division's Transportation Services at **780-963-8452**. Staff will confirm your contact information and resend the email or letter with your live link.

Hot Lunch

The hot lunch system will open March 10 and close March 22 for April's hot lunch orders. Watch our social media page for reminders. Hot lunch is only available on Mondays this year and provided through vendors. If you haven't already, please sign up through our hot lunch system to get the updates. Before you place an order please make sure you are aware of our new rules. The most important one for you to know is that this is a purchase at your own risk. We will not be offering any refunds unless closures are mandated by the Government, in which case those will be done at the end of the year, minus any banking fees. Full details of the policy are on the hot lunch website. By ordering hot lunch for your child it is a win win, you get a day off of packing a lunch and you also support our school! Hot lunch is volunteer run and is used as a small fundraiser for the needs of the school, which includes the new playgrounds for the new school.

Here's how to get started...(you must register again regardless if you've had an account in the past)

- ✓ Enter Access Code HLSP if asked
- ✓ Complete the rest of the registration form. (Including your email address will ensure you receive reminder emails about hot lunch order deadlines, and your child's hot lunch order for the upcoming week)
- ✓ Click the "Register Now" button at the bottom
- ✓ Follow the instructions to add each child in your family who attends SPC. Once your child(ren) are registered, click on "Orders"
- ✓ Proceed to order hot lunch for your child(ren)

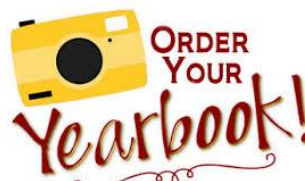
Available On-Line March 19 at 3:30pm
